



Biography Curtis M. Bergen

After receiving his undergraduate degree in Spanish from Arizona State University in 1989, Mr. Bergen graduated cum laude from Arizona State University College of Law in December, 1992. He was licensed as an attorney in Arizona in May of 1993, and admitted to the U.S. District Court in 1995.

While in law school, Mr. Bergen was a Willard H. Pedrick Scholar and a recipient of a Koontz Scholarship. He is a recipient of the Order of the Coif. From 1996 to 2003, Mr. Bergen was associated with Teilborg, Sanders and Parks, P.C.; in 2004 he joined Bowman and Brooke LLP where he was an equity partner. In 2007 he reunited with former colleagues from Teilborg, Sanders and Parks at the firm of Jardine, Baker, Hickman and Houston.

Mr. Bergen focused his 30 years of practice on medical malpractice defense litigation and licensing board discipline matters.
